**Biography.** Dr. Hall is a geologist with the U.S. Geological Survey Central Energy Resources Science Center based in Denver, Colorado. At the USGS, she leads the uranium resource evaluation project for the US, and also works on uranium environmental projects. She is the Chair of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development – Nuclear Energy Agency/International Atomic Energy Agency’s Uranium Group, which produces the uranium “Red Book”. Dr. Hall is the first US representative elected to chair the Uranium Group in more than 30 years, and the first woman to serve in this position.



Dr. Hall has B.S. from Smith College, and M.S. from the University of California, Davis, and Ph.D. from the University of Ottawa. Before joining the US Geological Survey, she worked in the private sector for ~20 years as a mineral exploration geologist and ore resource modeler.
